



Olympic Gardens and Racing Track area to include Golf Course and City Farm

September 22, 2021 – City of Mount Vema development, master design update: The eastern area of the City of Mount Vema allocated for the Olympic Garden to the south and Racing Track to the north has been changed.

The Racing Track area will now include a Golf Course and a City Farm. The most eastern area of the floating city from south to north will now be referred as the Olympic Gardens which includes the Olympic Gardens, the Racing Track, the Golf Course, and the City Farm.

As a special administrative zone, the area will be referred to as The Olympic Gardens and Central Park and, will be administered by its own Governor who will be elected by the people for a term of four years but without a Governor’s seat in Congress.

However, the Zone will have its own representative in Congress who will be elected by the people for a term of four years. The Representative will be referred to as: Congress Man or Congress Woman for The Olympic Gardens and Central Park with a seat in the House of Representatives (The Congress of Mount Vema) where he/she will work to protect the interest of The Special Administration Zone in accordance with their manifesto and mission.
