



# Foreign citizens detained or convicted in Mount Vema to be sent to Russia

**October 24, 2021** – The Vema Seamount Authority is reaching out to Putin to ask Russia to hold foreign citizens who are detained or convicted in Mount Vema until the City of Mount Vema is completed.

His Mount Vema Majesty King Peter Goldishman is proposing to offer financial compensation to Russia to help with security, detain and hold prisoners, as His Mount Vema Majesty's security services prepare to enforce the laws in relation to immigration, merchant marine and shipping, customs and excise, sea fish, marine conservation, and all relevant rules that might affect the safety of people and property within the Mount Vema territorial waters.

The authorization to enforce the laws was given early this month but the plan was to start later. However, with several people and vessels defying the law and continuing to violate it, and with the government currently monitoring the movements of more unauthorized vessels in Mount Vema, The Vema Seamount Authority is speeding up the process.

Works in Mount Vema are about to start and Mount Vema cannot take any risks. Mount Vema sought a security deal with the USA but because it cannot afford to wait any longer, it is reaching out to Russia.
