



# Foreign Affairs to open diplomatic offices as Mount Vema identifies a freeport to get started

**November 23, 2021** – The Royal Mount Vema Department of Foreign Affairs told VSBCnews sources on Monday that Mount Vema will open diplomatic offices to establish and strengthen strategic cooperation with countries that could play a key role in terms of logistics during the construction of the city of Mount Vema.

As final preparations are made to start building works within its jurisdiction in Mount Vema, the Office of Lady Trinity, the Royal Mount Vema Department of Foreign Affairs confirmed the news today that the Kingdom of Mount Vema will be opening 2 diplomatic offices in Asia, 1 in Europe, 1 in North America, and 1 in South America.

The confirmation from the Royal Mount Vema Department comes after news that Mount Vema has identified a freeport that it could use to get construction started. The location of the freeport is not ideal but is an important step to get logistics and passengers to and from Mount Vema.

As more freeports are identified in the future, and until more trade facilitation deals can be secured, Mount Vema officials are now confident that construction schedules will be met, as Mount Vema officially opens its business-to-business market, to be later followed by the opening of its business-to-consumer market.
