



FMA, The Food and Medicines Agency is opening facilities overseas – Sources

June 09, 2021 – FMA, The Food and Medicines Agency of Mount Vema, is considering to open facilities overseas. A source familiar with the plans told VSBCnews on Tuesday.

The Food and Medicines Agency of Mount Vema (FMA), is a division of the Royal Mount Vema Department of Health, also known as the Health Authority of the Kingdom of Mount Vema.

The FMA, is responsible for protecting and promoting public health through the control and supervision of food safety, dietary supplements, prescription and over-the-counter pharmaceutical products including medications, vaccines, biopharmaceuticals, blood transfusions, medical devices, electromagnetic radiation emitting devices (ERED), cosmetics, animal foods & feed and veterinary products.

The source told VSBCnews that the Agency is looking for options now, because it must be operational before construction starts. This is maybe, according to our source because the Agency expects its services to be in demand within the next few weeks as the City of Mount Vema projects gain momentum.

The FMA has already started its work on preparing to enforce Royal Mount Vema Orders regulating lasers, and including cellular phones, as well as control of diseases, including infectious diseases.

As companies prepare for the City of Mount Vema, The FMA seeks to aggressively expand its workforce globally, which will include field offices and laboratories overseas to ensure that anything heading to Mount Vema has been tested and approved in accordance with Royal Mount Vema Standards.
