



Competition for talented players intensifies – Southland Basketball joins the race

June 11, 2021 – The global search for talent among Mount Vema clubs is already becoming a competition itself, even before the league started. Who will find and hire the best available talent, who will raise sufficient capital to keep spending and who would be able to win enough games to win the first championship.

Southland Club which is listed on the Mount Vema Stock Exchange was up 4.17 points, about 12.04% in the early trading session today. The Gollexi Index, at the Mount Vema Stock Exchange reached 3,196.63 points.

The Mount Vema Basketball Association (MVBA) is expected to be among the most significant professional basketball league in terms of popularity, salaries, talent, and level of competition. Just like other sports competitions in Mount Vema, it will be broadcasted globally.

There will be two leagues the men’s basketball league to be known as MBA, and the women's basketball league to be known as the FBA. However, they will all be collectively referred to by the Mount Vema Sports Federation as the Mount Vema Basketball Association (MVBA).
