



San Miguel Furniture seeks Government advise on where to set up factories

June 21, 2021 – San Miguel Furniture, the company that designs to sell ready to assemble furniture for the Kingdom of Mount Vema is in talks with His Mount Vema Majesty's Government as the company seeks advise on where to set up its factories overseas.

San Miguel Furniture, according to a VSBCnews source is not sure which countries will provide the trade facilitation needed that will enable the company to set up production facilities and coordinate its operations to and from Mount Vema.

The talks could prove difficult for the Government as it has not yet secured any reliable deal which is the cause of many setbacks for companies such as Handy Deed with so many projects on hold, including a group of Mount Vema companies which are anxious to get started due to the need to stay on schedule.

The company which is the main contractor for all matters related to street and household furniture for the City of Mount Vema, has started working on designs of its ready to assemble furniture for the Kingdom of Mount Vema after securing deals for the design of unique furniture for the floating City that can meet innovative, and functional requirements, as well as aesthetic appeal, with eco-friendly simplicity.

San Miguel Furniture is listed on the Mount Vema Stock Exchange and seeks to develop new concepts to help reduce costs and use of packaging in Mount Vema.

All furniture and related products will be initially designed outside the Vema Seamount Territory, to be later moved to Mount Vema. However, most products will be largely manufactured in developing countries and shipped to the Kingdom of Mount Vema where the final assembly will be performed by property developers or by the end-user (the consumer).
