



# Construction of Breakwaters and 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue project has officially started – Handy Deed

**July 05, 2021** – Handy Deed, the leading construction company of Mount Vema and the main contractor for City of Mount Vema projects has confirmed that it has officially begun works on the City of Mount Vema breakwaters and the 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue project.

The announcement is symbolic as it marks the begin of the City of Mount Vema construction related works, as the company moves for the first time from the drawing boards (planning) to field work which will start outside Mount Vema and will move gradually to the Vema Seamount Territory by sections.

This announcement was expected after VSBCnews reported in May that Handy Deed had embarked on a global campaign to find cement and concrete specialists after the company got the greenlight from the Mount Vema Ministry of National Development and Land Maintenance to start works on the construction of the City of Mount Vema breakwaters.

Sources told VSBCnews back in May, that the company was looking for people with specialist knowledge in cement and concrete mixing for all types of environments including structural engineers, site engineers, geological oceanographers, geotechnical engineers, and engineering geologists.

Today's announcement it is not an indication that Handy Deed has everything it needs but it has the basics to get started, according to our sources. Handy Deed is still hiring labour and specialist consultants, creative innovators and people who use their technical minds to design structures, or people who wish to contribute in any other way to solve problems and shape the world around them, to join its global team of City of Mount Vema project participants.

The Breakwaters, is the most important part of the floating city project which includes the 20 kilometers road (5<sup>th</sup> Avenue) that will make the City of Mount Vema set of barriers, designed to protect the floating city from the force of the waves.
