



Westland Elections – Title Plan owners can submit candidacy to stand for Zone 57

July 20, 2021 – Owners of Title Plans to be located within Zone 57 of the District of Westland, can from today officially submit their candidacy to stand as District Representative for Zone 57 for a term of four years.

If you wish to represent Zone 57 of the District of Westland where your property will be located, from today you can start to exercise your right to stand for District Representative for the Congress of Mount Vema.

Title Plan owners must meet Royal Order - Rule 28042021-1 which states that an investor must share the same values as most of the people that make the society of His Mount Vema Majesty's realm, and the standards set by the Crown of Mount Vema, otherwise the candidacy will be rejected.

Candidates will be vetted by the security services and approved by the sovereign. Once approved, elections will take place, and the owners of the Title-Plans within Zone 57 will decide who will best represent their interests in Congress now. However, in the future the residents of Zone 57 will also have the right to vote.

Westland is an administrative division of the Kingdom of Mount Vema – The Vema Seamount Territory, as well as a District of the City of Mount Vema Project. As a City Project, the District will be both residential and commercial, divided into seven neighbourhoods with a population capacity of about 50,000 people.

With a seat in the House of Representatives (The Congress of Mount Vema) which initially will be a virtual seat, the Representative for Zone 57 will work to protect the interest of the owners of Title Plans, local businesses, and people which they are elected to represent.
