



Mount Vema is open to informal trade relations with Canada to facilitate imports

July 22, 2021 – Canadian companies can export to the Vema Seamount Territory with informal relations between Canada and Mount Vema. Sources at the Royal Mount Vema Department of Foreign Affairs told VSBCnews.

Mount Vema wants to have deals in place before the provisional Port of Mount Vema is ready, so any formal or informal deal it can secure now would be ideal. A source familiar with the developments plan told VSBCnews.

Mount Vema is already open to informal relations with many countries to facilitate trade, and it will be setting up more than 50 virtual Embassies this year to assist foreign companies expressing interest to provide goods and services to the Vema Seamount Territory.

Although His Mount Vema Majesty’s Government does not expect to see any formal establishment of diplomatic relations with other countries any time soon, the virtual Embassies are already opening the doors to Mount Vema. The current focus, according to our sources is trade.

With Canada, the Mount Vema Government is interested in the establishment of facilities that enables Mount Vema companies to import wood and related products from Canada to provide building materials to the City of Mount Vema project.
