



# Mount Vema Independence Day - New bank notes to mark 15 years of history

**August 01, 2021** – The Central Bank of Mount Vema is issuing new bank notes to mark 15 years of establishment of statehood.

This 1<sup>st</sup> of August 2021 marks the 15<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the significant establishment of statehood based on this ancient island (known today as Mount Vema) which has eroded by millions of years of wave action.

The Bank of Mount Vema will be retiring the old bank notes from August 3<sup>rd</sup> 2021 which coincides with latest announcement that also from August 3<sup>rd</sup> people, companies and governments earning money in Mount Vema currency will be able to transfer funds to more than 160 countries.

Independence Day is one of the most special events of the year for the Mount Vema Society, and this year bank holiday has been moved to Monday, August 2<sup>nd</sup>, to celebrate the day Vema Seamount, and its adjacent waters became a sovereign territory.
