



Mount Vema seeks trade and investment worth 5 billion golles with Brazil

August 11, 2021 – The Kingdom of Mount Vema is seeking a Trade Agreement with Brazil worth 5 billion golles, aiming to open the market of goods trade, rules of origin, safekeeping, cooperation in technical and sanitary norms, technological and technical cooperation, and customs cooperation.

The latest poll carried out by VSBCnews in Brazil indicates that more than 40,000 Brazilians are expected to visit Mount Vema once construction activities of the city move to Mount Vema.

The number is 40% higher than it was in 2018. Due to that growth, the Mount Vema Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Tourism aims to bring 50,000 Brazilians once construction moves to Mount Vema.

The basic strategies are the expansion of the Representative Office of the Mount Vema Ministry of Tourism in Brazil and the facilitation route between Brazil and Mount Vema, with the Mount Vema airline and sealine W-Southern ready to begin its operations first by sea as soon as a deal is reached, to be followed later by air.

Mount Vema will also seek exchanges with Brazil in the fields of agriculture, security, science, technology, and innovation to illustrate the synergies that could be formed in several areas, which could be explored and stimulate reciprocal investments.

Mount Vema will formally invite the Brazilian Export and Investment Promotion Agency (Apex-Brasil) to open a commercial office in Mount Vema as soon as construction starts to establish and strengthen partnership in the areas of innovation, technology, and investments.
