



Maternity Care Unit prepares for the City of Mount Vema – Sources

May 26, 2021 – MVHS, the Mount Vema Health Service has begun to prepare its specialist units for the City of Mount Vema sources told VSBCnews. The healthcare institution which will be free for all in Mount Vema has started first preparations with its Maternity Care Unit which is part of the MVHS – Post Natal, a division of the Mount Vema International Health Services.

The service provides Post Natal Advise and Income Support during and after the postnatal period, beginning immediately after the birth of a child and extending until the child is 3 years of age and is ready for pre-academy.

In Mount Vema the Post Natal Advise and Income Support services will be available for all residents, however the service is already available to Mount Vema citizens throughout the world, including those who may not be citizens but work or provide services to a legal entity of Mount Vema.

The Mount Vema Post Natal is known among community members as FPAIS (The Family Planning Advise and Income Support). Although income support is only for people with a Mount Vema bank account, beneficiaries must first register to use the service which is free of charge, with all expenses paid out of the treasury of His Mount Vema Majesty’s Government.

If a member of the community wishes to have a child and cannot meet any of the requirements – the significant amount of resources of "Raising" a child such as: time, social, financial, and environmental, His Mount Vema Majesty’s Government in partnership with Post Natal services, helps to assure that resources are made available anywhere in the world, and such help increases if a person applies for the right education or training at a Royal Mount Vema Foundation Academy in their country or region that would prepare them for work in Mount Vema or for a legal entity of Mount Vema for a minimum period of five years.
